

Creating the Solution

Demonstrates excellent technical skills when making the solution. *(Ask a teacher to examine your product/solution)*

What feedback have teachers given you about your product?

(Ask a classmate to examine your product/solution)

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Students demonstrate that the planning process was sufficiently thorough if the final product matches the planning drawing and no changes were made to the plan, in whatever form it was presented. If the drawings/diagrams and the plan match what has been made, then students have followed the plan.

If a student does not follow the plan, it will usually result in the solution not fully meeting the specification and/or matching the design detailed in the drawings/diagrams.

EXAMPLE of Feedback from Peer: Wooden Car

The product looked nice because it was painted well.

There were a few colors that dripped on the edges that could be fixed up.

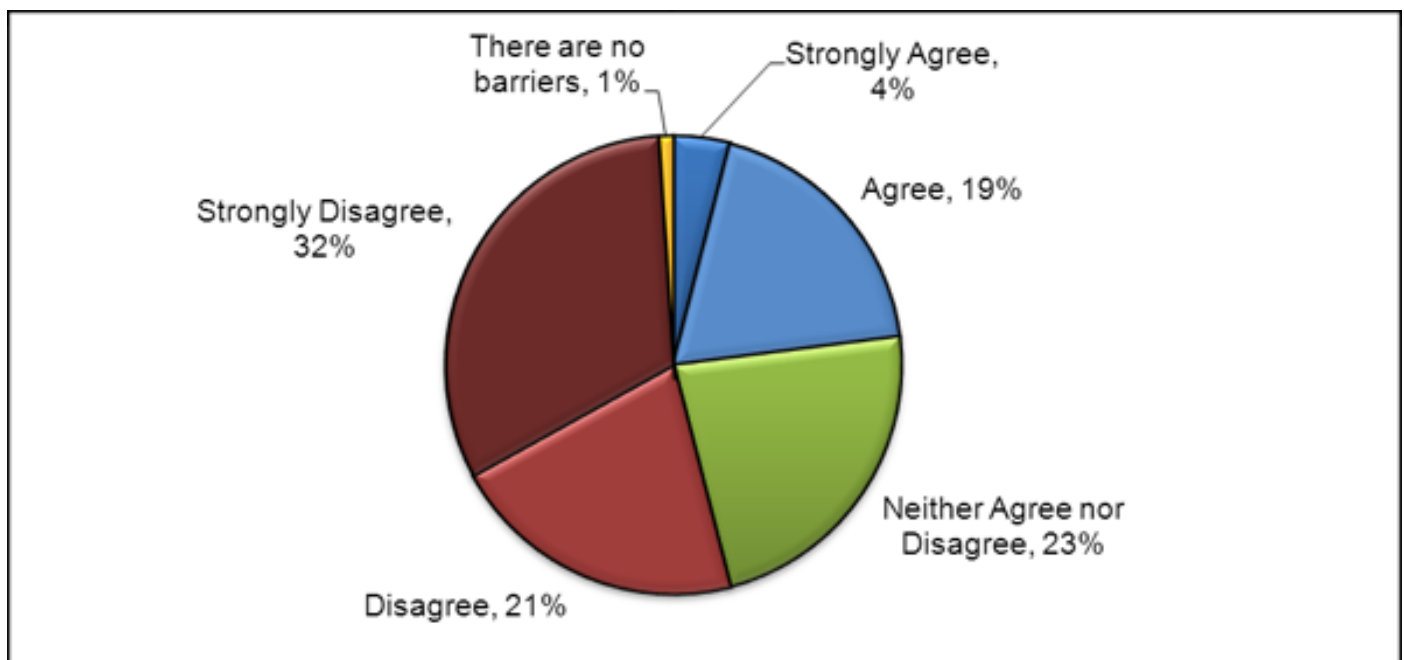
I like the style of the wheels that were chosen, but maybe some bigger ones would have looked neat.

The product is made out of wood, so I think it will be durable, however, where the wheel and axle meet might be reinforced with a bit of metal or something.

EXAMPLE of Feedback from Peer: Website

- The site looked nice, but I think that was because of the template that was chosen
- I didn't understand why the about me menu item was added when it was supposed to be a company website (Maybe it could be changed to about us and reflect that more)
- The color scheme was nice, but it could have been more effective if blues were chosen for a company website instead of reds and purples.
- Some of the fonts were hard to read (Maybe a simple font with a sans-serif would be easier to read)
- One of the pages had nothing on it (Was this a mistake? Maybe it should be taken out or a message should read that it is still under development)
- Overall, the website seems to get the message across but I don't think I would return because there are better ones out there
- I wonder how this website gives me something that I can't get somewhere else?
