

## Origami Fortune-Teller

**To the Teacher:** Have students make Origami Fortune-Tellers to review a chapter or unit. Divide students into small groups. Assign each group one part of a chapter or unit. Then, have each student within the group make one Origami Fortune-Teller featuring specific information about the chapter or unit.

#### **Materials:**

8" x 8" (20.3 cm x 20.3 cm) white paper square Pen or fine-tipped marker Markers or colorful pencils Scissors

#### **Directions\*:**

- 1. Fold the paper square diagonally as shown in figure 1.
- 2. Open the paper and fold diagonally in the opposite direction as shown in figure 2.
- **3.** Open the paper and fold each corner to the center of the square as shown in figure 3.
- 4. Flip over the square and fold from the corners to the center as shown in figure 4.
- **5.** Print one question on each triangular section of each flap. You should have room for eight questions as shown in figure 5.
- 6. On the back of each flap, write the answer to the corresponding question.
- 7. When completed, fold the square in half as shown in figure 6. Open the square.
- 8. Fold the square in half the other way and open as shown in figure 7.
- **9.** Flip over the square and write *north*, *south*, *east*, and *west* on the four large squares.
- 10. Slide your fingers under the four large squares and let a group member choose a direction. Count the letters in the direction she chose and open and close the Origami Fortune-Teller that many times. Move the Origami Fortune-Teller one quarter turn to the right and ask the group member the question that is written in the chosen direction.
- 11. After reviewing with your group, exchange Origami Fortune-Tellers with another group to review their chapter or unit information.
