




Q5 When I leave class, I understand the purpose of my homework assignment.










Q9 My teachers offer me choice in what, how, and/or how much I do for homework.








Q10 Having a lot of major assignments due on the same day happens:

Examination comes from the verb "to examine" - the first definition of which is to "inspect in detail; to investigate thoroughly"

Why have exams at all?

- Benefit of the "spacing effect" studying something a second time can help to bring learning into longterm memory (Kornell, 2010)
- Formalized opportunity for students review material from over a longer period of time, think critically about what they have studied, review hard-to-grasptopics, discuss subject matter with classmates and instructors — all of which enhance learning
- 3. A skill set for Diploma and Uni/College

Grade 12's sit 24 hours of cumulative exams...




- Grades 11, 10, and 9 sit comprehensive semester exams. Scores are not weighted or averaged.
- Grades 6-8 take summative assessments under simulated exam conditions during exam week.
 Scores are not weighted of averaged.

safety needs: security, physiological safety


