

Modifications To My Design:

I believe my design could have had a lot more modifications. There are parts of it that I would have improved if given more time.

- The faces could have had a more professional finish if I had spent more time researching different finishes.
- An idea that I had thought about using was that instead of making my clock with wood, I
 could have made it with acrylic. I would have then been able to engrave many designs into
 the acrylic.
- I had thought about staining the wood with a dark stain and then applying numerous coats
 of paint.
- I was happy with the base but in order to make the whole clock a bit more solid, I could
 have used a second or third layer on the base creating a step design, which would also
 have added to the clock's stability.
- Looking back perhaps the background of the clock face should have been white in order to give a good contrast for the clock hands, which would have made reading the time from a distance easier.
- While the original design was to be an image and outline of the Jumierah Beach Hotel and
 even though it wasn't created in the end, it may have been better if I had chosen a more
 iconic Dubai landmark such as the Burj al Arab hotel or the Burj Khalifa as an outline,
 because either of these two would have been a lot more recognizable.
- The dowelling design to hold the clock to the base was a good idea and I will use it again in any similar creation.
- I didn't focus as much as I should have when I was varnishing the base of the clock. The varnish was messy and the base began to feel rough as the varnish collected dust.
- The general paintwork on the face of my clock was not as good as it could be as I found it hard to not make the paint run. Next time, I would take a lot more care when doing this procedure in my project.
- All of the edges of my clock are smooth however they were very flat. I made the edges of
 the clock flat as I was trying to make it the shape of the Jumeirah Beach Hotel. When I
 realized I was going to make the face display an image of sand dunes, I forgot to sand
 down the edges so that they were very round and almost circular.
- When I drilled the dowel holes into the base of the bottom of the clock, I didn't drill very
 deep which meant that it wouldn't be that strong. Next time, I would be sure to make the
 holes deeper, and also to carefully measure the depths of both of the holes.
