search phrases

works with most search engines

- (minus)

eliminate irrelevant results.
[mullet -hairstyle]

works with most search engines

site:

search within specific websites
[site:nationalgeographic.com]

*search specific domain types
(including countries)*

[site:edu.au] or [site:gov]

works with most search engines (blekko uses [/site])

OR

*expand search options
and include more than
one way of saying an
idea.*

[jazz OR blues]

works with most search engines

define:

quick definition

[define:poignant]

works with most search engines

Research Strategies:

★Use the RIGHT WORDS

- look at your search engine results page (SERP) and other details for suggestions
- use a dictionary, or the [define:] operator to find the definition of suggested words
- consider the vocabulary of the time, region, academic level, etc.
- Consider context terms (extra words that help explain what you want) e.g. tables, figures, clipart, infographic, etc.

★Look in the right PLACE

- If you know of a great site for the info you need, go there. e.g. youtube, wikipedia, IMDB.com
- Consider the options of different media/information (images, video, books, maps, scholar, news, etc.)

★Use the EXTRA OPTIONS (dropdown boxes) to further filter/refine your searches!
